

Tyler Lang and Kevin Olliff were indicted under the Animal Enterprise Terrorism Act (AETA) for allegedly freeing, and conspiring to free, mink and fox from fur farms. They face up to ten years in prison if convicted.

The AETA is a federal law that classifies activism in the pursuit of animal liberation as an act of terrorism and labels those who fight for the freedom of animals as terrorists. This law was created to silence and paralyze the animal liberation movement, and it must be fought both in courtrooms and out in the streets by staying active for the animals.

Please support Kevin and Tyler in any way you can and resist State repression!

Tyler and Kevin were arrested during a traffic stop in rural Illinois and charged at the state level with "possession of burglary tools." Both Tyler and Kevin took non-cooperating plea deals on the state charges, but they are now facing the AETA charges. After the AETA indictment, Tyler was released on bail and Kevin is being held in federal custody pending trial.
