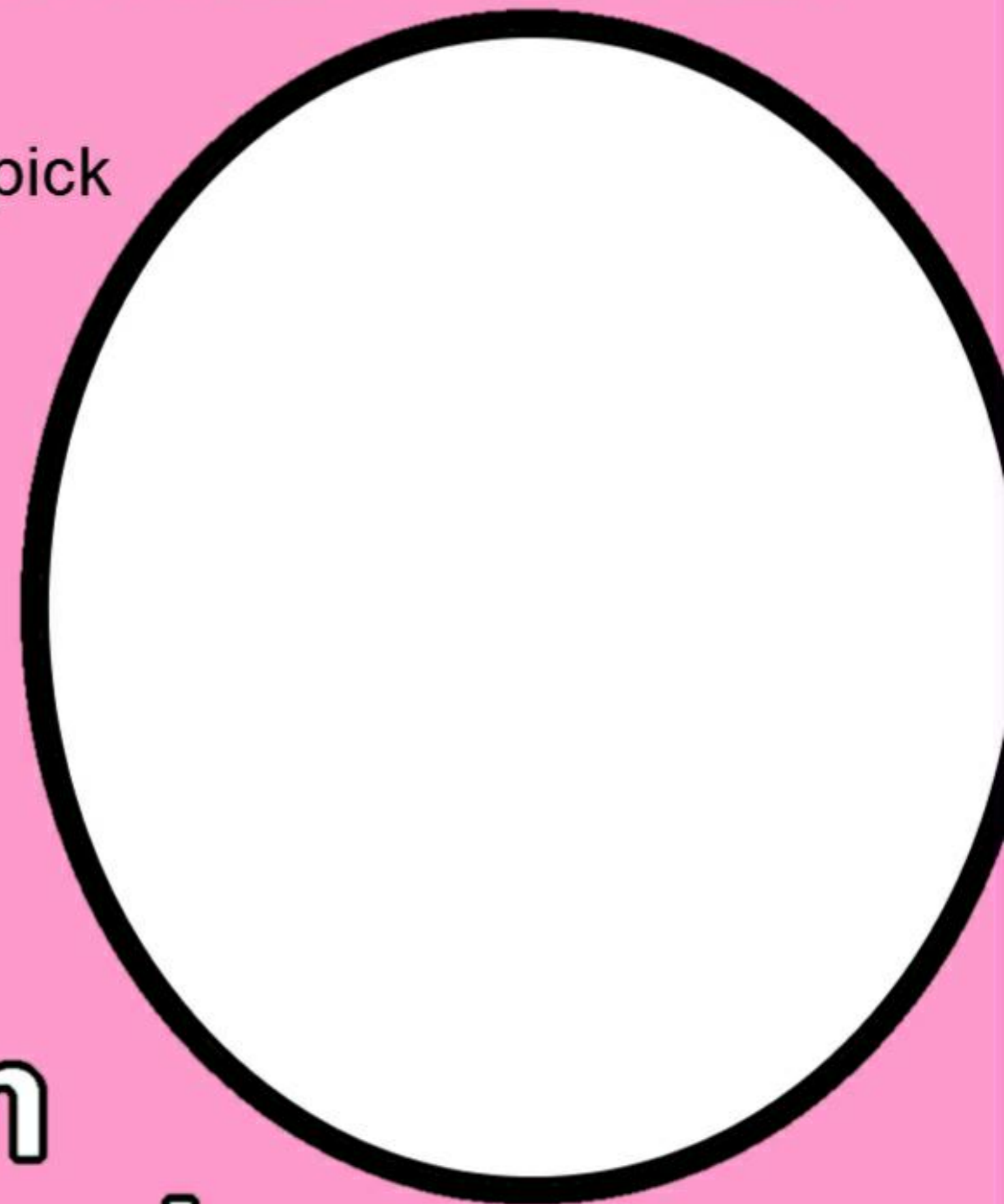

Q:If you could be cast in any of the new hot shows on TV, which show will it be and why?

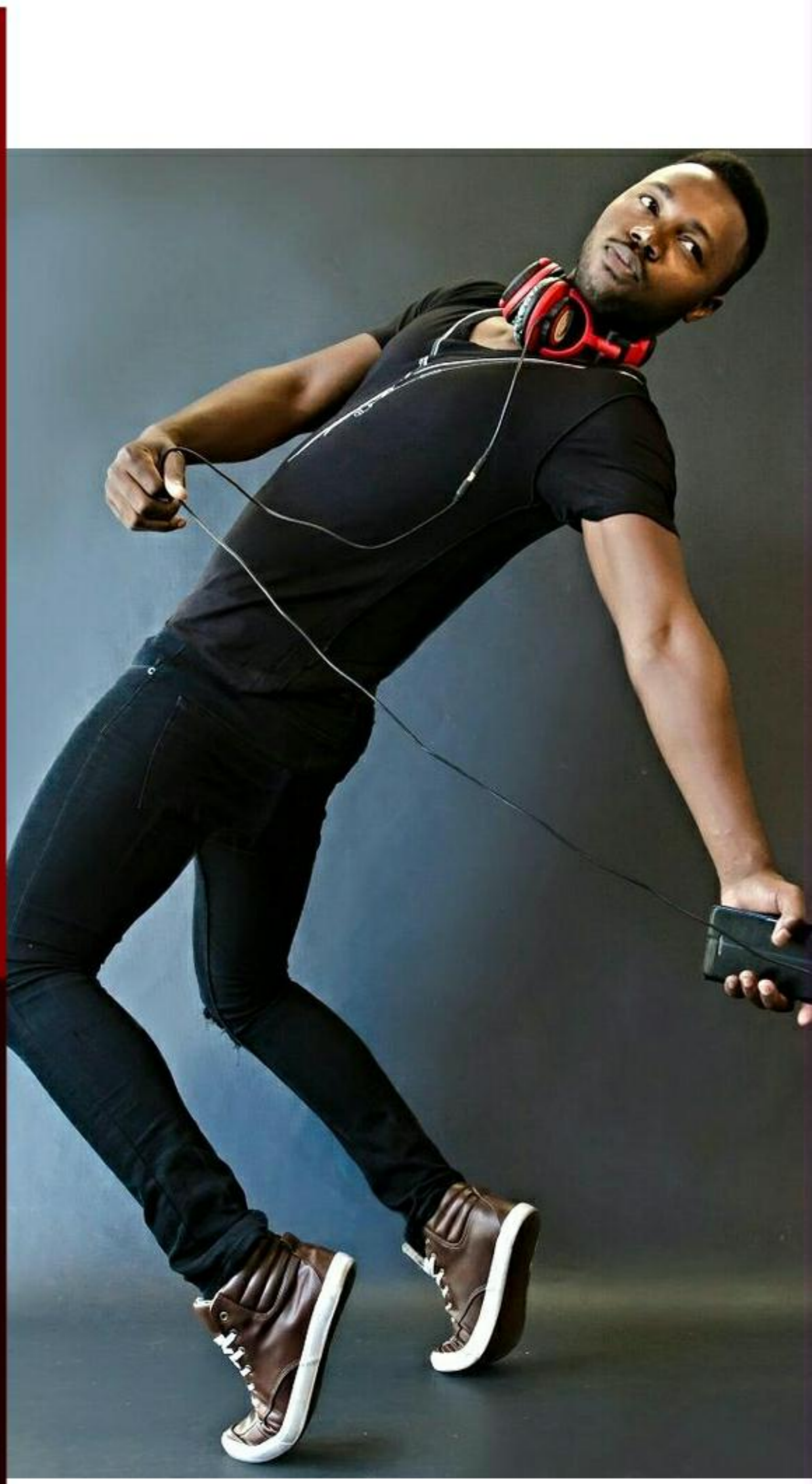

The modern way

other side

South Africa has the eighth-highest suicide
rate in the world

The country had approximately 8 000 suicides a year. Around one million suicides were recorded each year globally.

Suicide is the third greatest cause of unnatural death in the country. Around 230 people tried to commit suicide daily, while 23 succeed. Research showed that psycho-social factors such as untreated mental illness, substance abuse, family problems, trauma, rape, and poverty could be contributing to suicidal feelings.

According to studies around 70% of people who committed suicide showed warning signs. Some of the warning signs are; talking or thinking about death often, clinical depression, the loss of interest in things one used to care about, putting affairs in order, a sudden change in behaviour, unexpected switch from being very sad to being very calm or appearing to be happy, visiting or calling people to say goodbye, and giving away possessions

People with signs of depression needed to be reminded that there was help available. The World Health Organisation found that despite the high number of suicides across the globe, help for people thinking of committing suicide was not prioritised in the public health system.

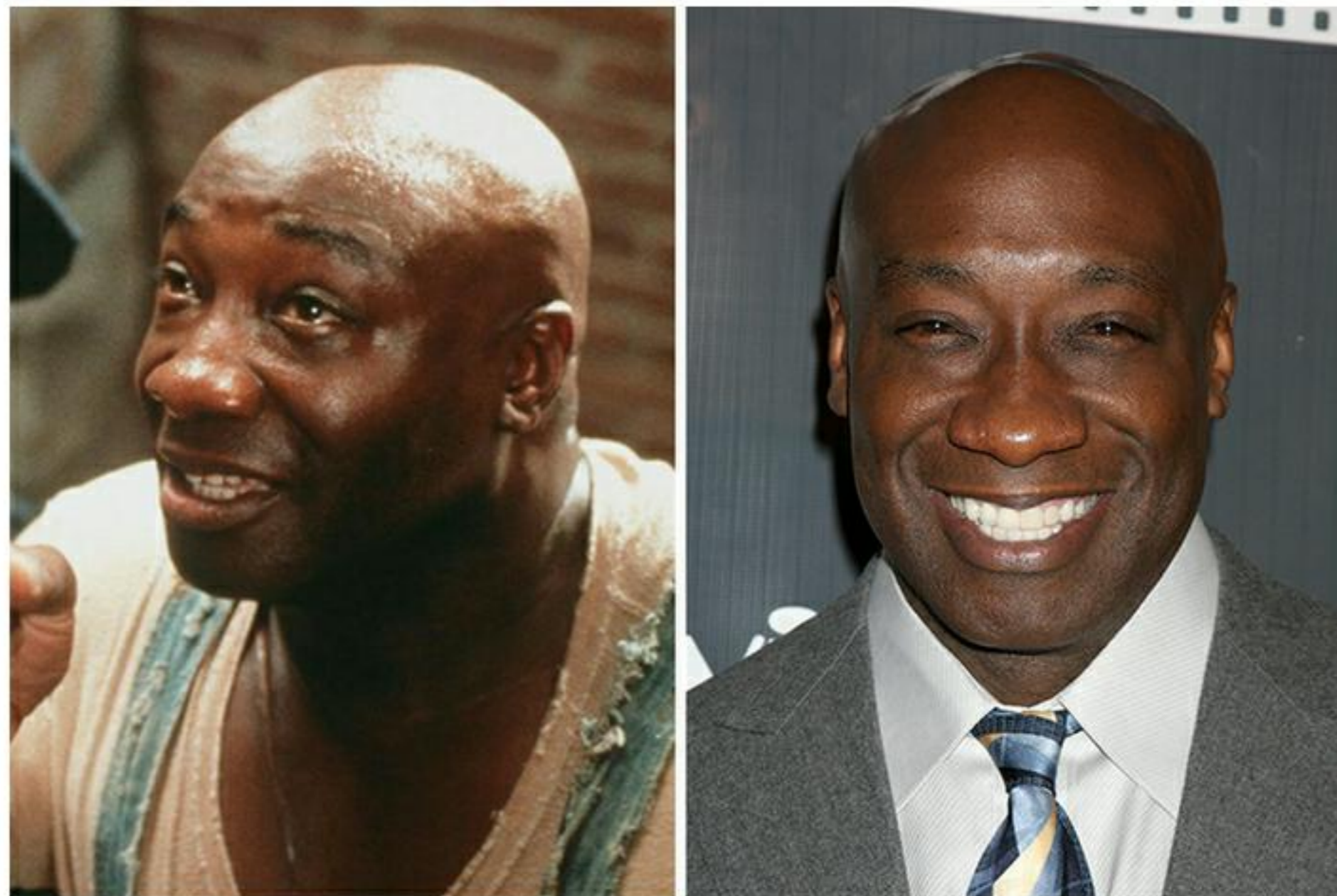

Andy Whitfield



It's always hard when a cast member dies during a show's run, but for *Spartacus: Blood and Sand*, the actor portraying its main character died. After completing work on the first season, Whitfield died from lymphoma on September 11, 2011. The role of Spartacus was recast and the show ran another two seasons.

Michael Clarke Duncan



Michael Clarke Duncan's death was probably the most publicized of anyone on this list, but not nearly enough was said about him considering what an accomplished actor he was. Duncan breathed life into the character of John Coffey in "The Green Mile," proved who the king of acting was in "Daredevil," and didn't monkey around during his time on set for "Planet of the Apes." Simply put, Michael Clarke Duncan was a big man with big acting talent, and his work ethic on set forced his coworkers to work even harder to match his level of dedication and energy. Michael Clarke Duncan was certainly no old man when he passed, but no one expected him to suffer a sudden heart attack at just 54 years old; when he spontaneously collapsed his girlfriend, Omarosa Manigault, attempted to perform CPR but he was hospitalized and after twenty days of support he passed on September 3rd in 2012.
