

司 庫 的 話

去年羊年的籌款晚會順利完成籌得了今年所需的差額基本開支費用,令圖書館進入了隱定的 一年。

貴人的出現,使圖書館在猴年吃了一顆定心丸。年初首先有不具名女士繼去年捐出一千一百元後,今年再捐出二千元。到四月舉行中文講故事比賽的時侯,又遇上熱心的教育機構 CINEC Education Group (Canada) Inc. 了解到圖書館的經營困難,慷慨解囊,捐出一萬大元,這是圖書館近年來收到的單一最大筆捐款。近日剛收到律師信通知 Shu-Wing Mak 先生的遺產中有五千元將捐贈給圖書館。


圖書館因為沒有職員管理而全靠義工服務,大 部分義工都是耆英長者,年輕義工因本身工作

問題,只能作有限度服務,在圖書館管理方面都有力不從心的地方,理事會也希望能吸引更多義工加入,以促進管理工作。

為了節省會計及核數費用,圖書館賬目盡量簡化,大部份活動開支都找贊助對冲,而沒有反應在會計賬目上,引致今年再申請部份贊助時缺乏有力的會計項目支持而落空。圖書館目前使用的最基本核數費用為一千元左右,但如果為了申請贊助而改用全盤核數,核數費用有可能高至四、五千元。司庫將吸取經驗,改善做帳方式,以待明年繼續申請贊助。

圖書館來年開支估計略有增長,主要在經過長時間沒有加租情況下,業主要求增加租金每月一百元至一千二百元,明年開支預算估計增至二萬元左右。

圖書館財務雖然暫時可以解決燃眉之急,但仍然需要大眾的持續關心和支持,希望借著今天晚上的籌款活動,讓大家把圖書館的情况廣為宣傳。薪火相傳,完全靠大眾力量。



終生當義工的夢 - 許陳秀華

花花世界,人生如夢,時光易渡,歲月不留人,故人生在世,如能以助人為快樂之本,必能在社區留下一點痕跡。

陳秀華(許太)是香港津校的退休教師,兒女均移居多倫多。多年前,參加美加東西岸旅行團,到溫哥華後,感到此地的環境 適合耆英生活,於是決定留居溫市。

習慣了繁忙生活的她來到溫哥華,也閒不下來,開始就在佛堂當起了義工。二零零五年六月轉入中僑互助委員會基金部當義工,每週五天,每天六小時,連續做了十一年。雖然在中僑的工作量比較大,但每逢初一,十五她還是會去佛堂當義工。

許太熱愛義工的工作,廣交朋友,中僑一年兩次的籌款活動,每次都盡心盡力籌得超過一千元善款。本以為可以終身為中僑服務,想不到今年三月底的人事大變遷,在新人事新制度下,大大的影響了她的精神。終於決定在做完7月百萬行籌款後離開中橋互助會。




CCLSA Vice President

Established in 1972, the Chinese Community Library Services Association (CCLSA) has a two-fold mandate. First, as an organization solely run by volunteers, CCLSA is dedicated to the preservation of the history of Chinese Canadians and the promotion of Chinese culture within Canada's cultural mosaic. As the only Chinese-language community library in North America, CCLSA has for the past 44 years been providing a wealth of informational resources, not only to the Chinese population, but also to members of the mainstream society, with the Chinese History Room's rare collection of written, audio and visual materials allowing both researchers and community users a rare glimpse into the life of early Chinese Canadians.

Secondly, CCLSA organizes a variety of community and cultural events and offers a wide range of programs, serving the needs of different age groups. For example, the annual Student Essay Competition and Children Storytelling Competition aim to foster an interest in learning Chinese – a rising global language and a vibrant local language – not only among the younger generation of Chinese Canadians, but also students of non-Chinese descent, by providing language learners the opportunity to strengthen their writing and public speaking skills. The success of both competitions is evidenced by the active participation of non-Chinese participants and their outstanding performance in recent years.


CCLSA places a strong emphasis on the promotion of the well-being of Chinese elders especially in the Chinatown/Strathcona/Downtown Eastside areas. These Chinese elders constitute a vulnerable group as language and cultural barriers often prevent them from accessing necessary resources. CCLSA volunteers provide oneon-one and group services, including translation/interpretation, form filing and English lessons, both at the library and at various senior housing project sites. Such services are essential in reducing the various challenges these senior residents may experience in their daily life. In particular, two federal New Horizons for Seniors grants have led to the establishment of a computer/multi-media room in 2008, and the purchasing of 20 tablet devices in 2014. Over three hundred Chinese seniors have since participated in the CCLSA Computer Literacy Initiative. While a majority of the seniors come from Chinatown/Strathcona/Downtown Eastside, many come from other areas in the Lower Mainland, including Burnaby, Richmond, and as far as Surrey and Coquitlam. Through this initiative, participants are able to expand their comfort zone by overcoming their intimidation with new technologies. All seniors gain hands-on experience in using computers and hand-held devices in a friendly and supportive environment. They also enjoy the opportunity to create their own e-mail or Facebook account, and are able to communicate with their oversea relatives and friends through video conferencing. Most importantly, many senior participants have decided to take on the mentorship role and share their knowledge beyond the Chinese community. As part of the outreach portion of the initiative, ten "Computer Road Shows" were held at various locations between 2014 and 2015, including the Central Library, UBC Learning Exchange, Vancouver Second Mile Society, local restaurants, and Chinatown/Strathcona/DTES senior housing buildings, in which senior mentors eagerly showcased their newly acquired knowledge and skills to the community.
