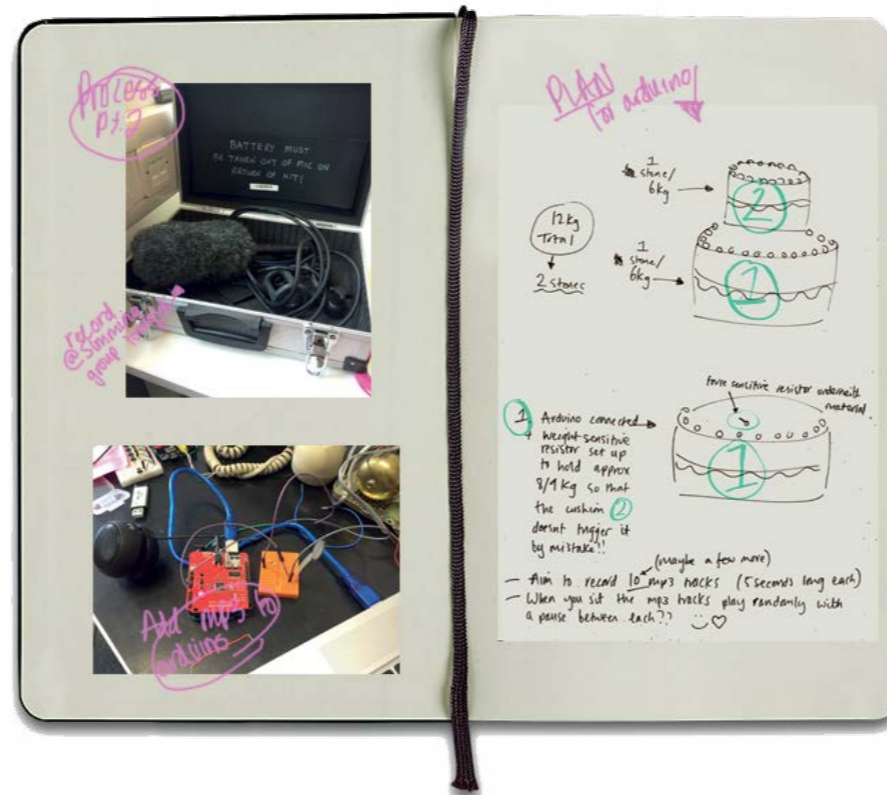

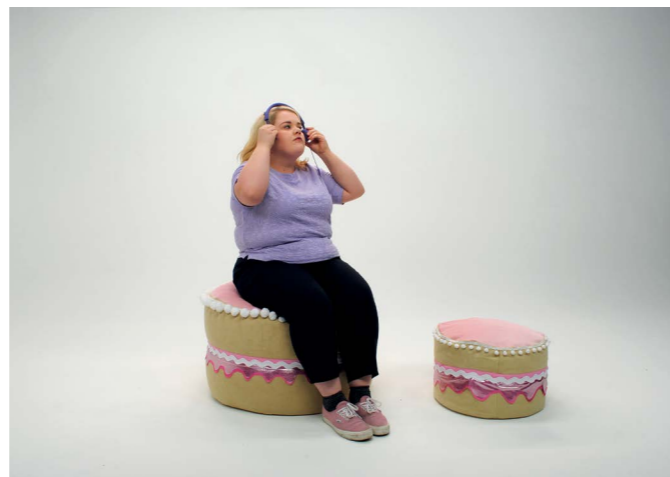
...and sit on it!

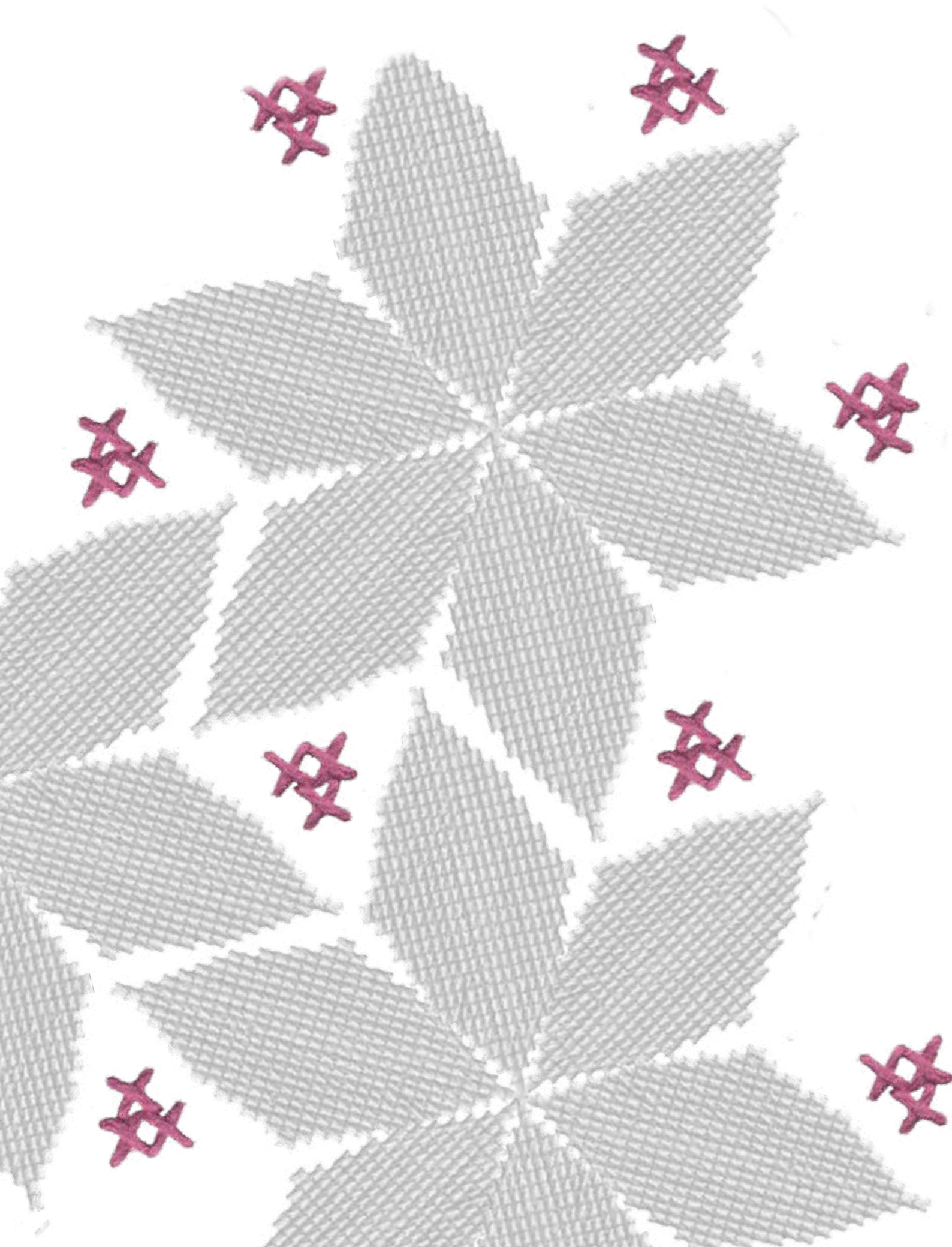

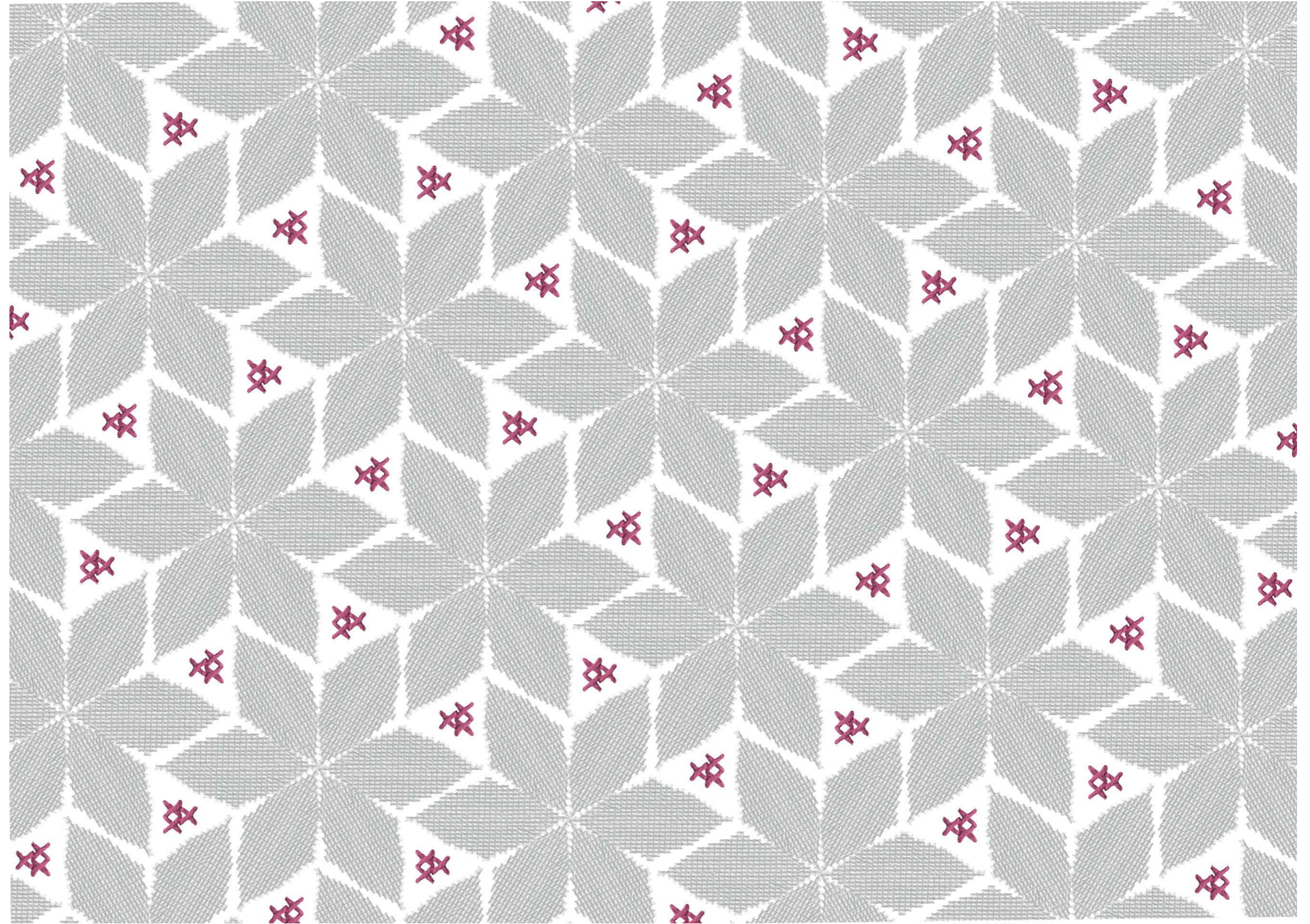



Oscar the Orca



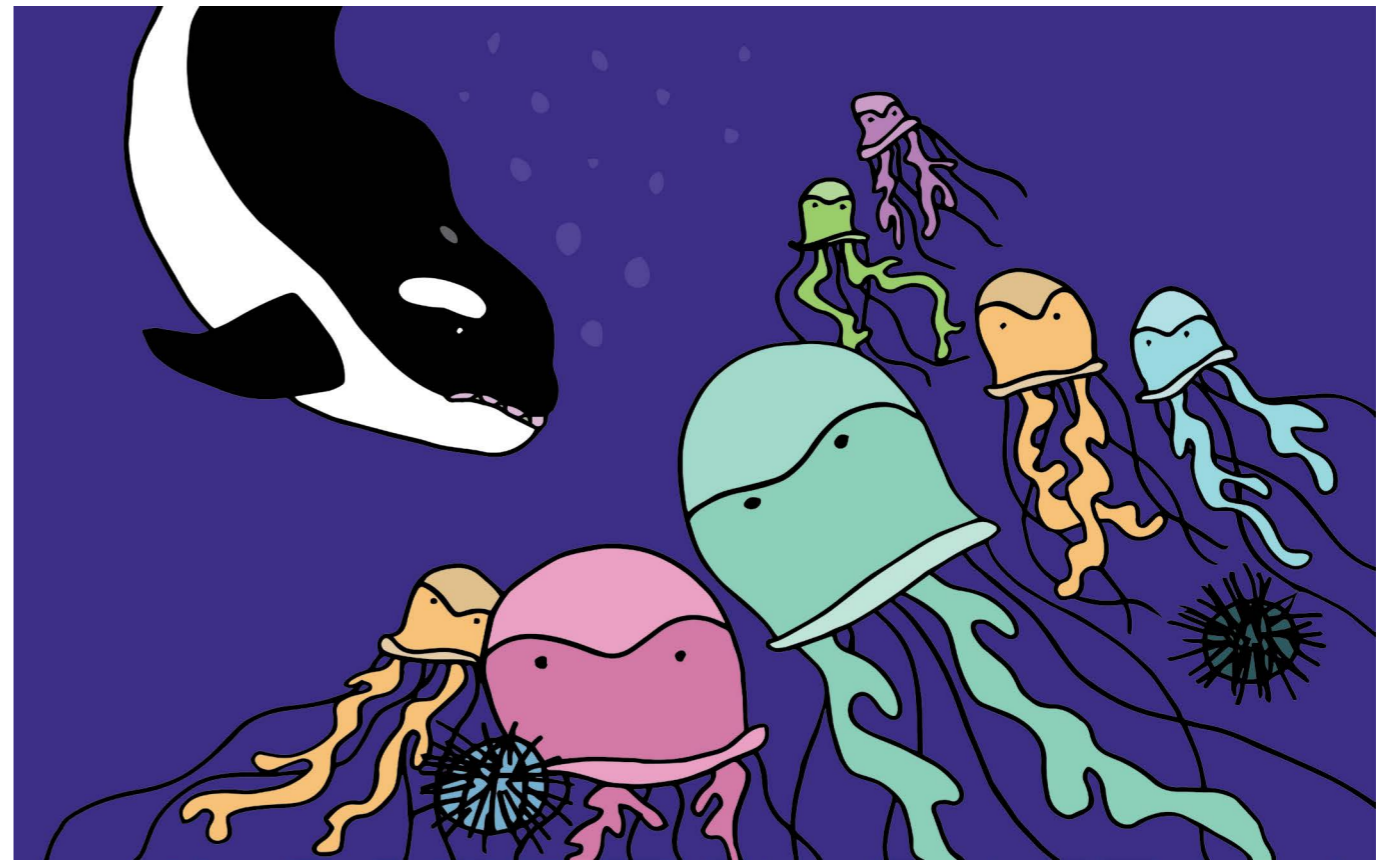
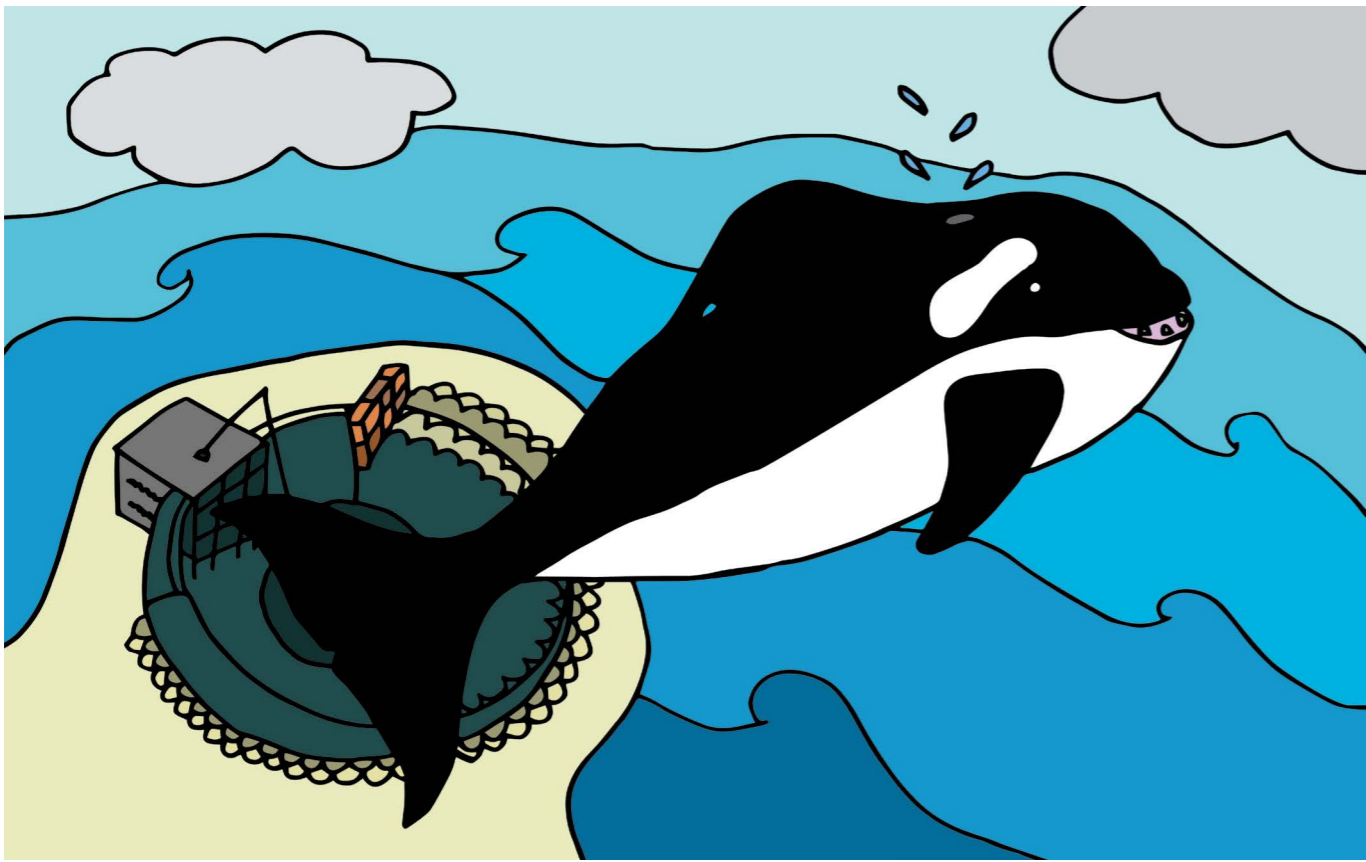
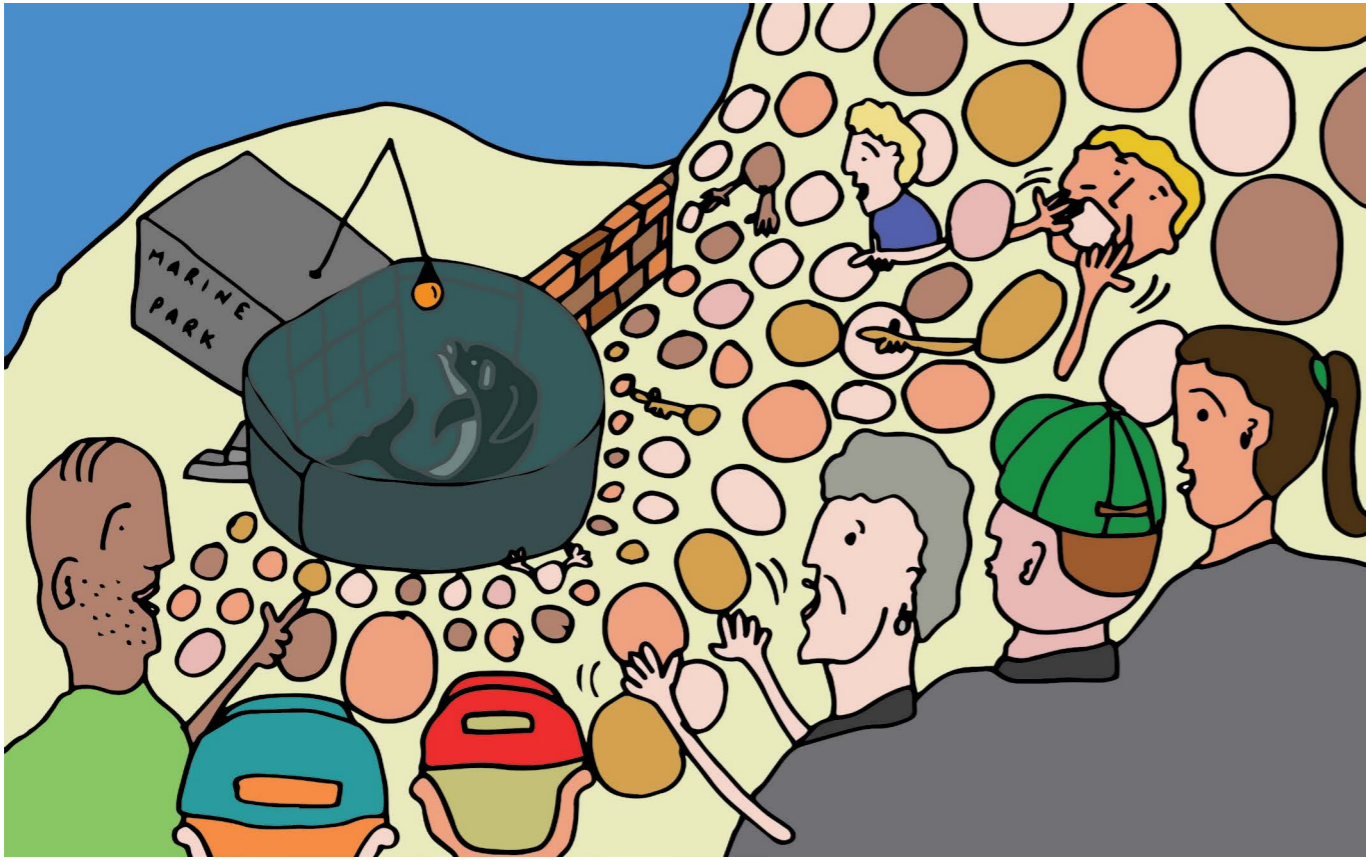
Oscar is scared of the big ocean after years in his tiny pool. But as he swims, he meets a friendly crab who tells Oscar to swim a little deeper...

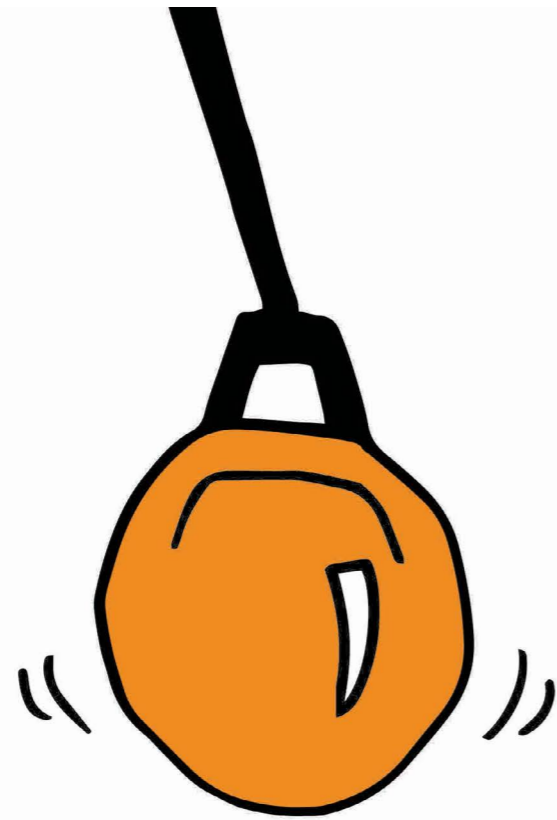

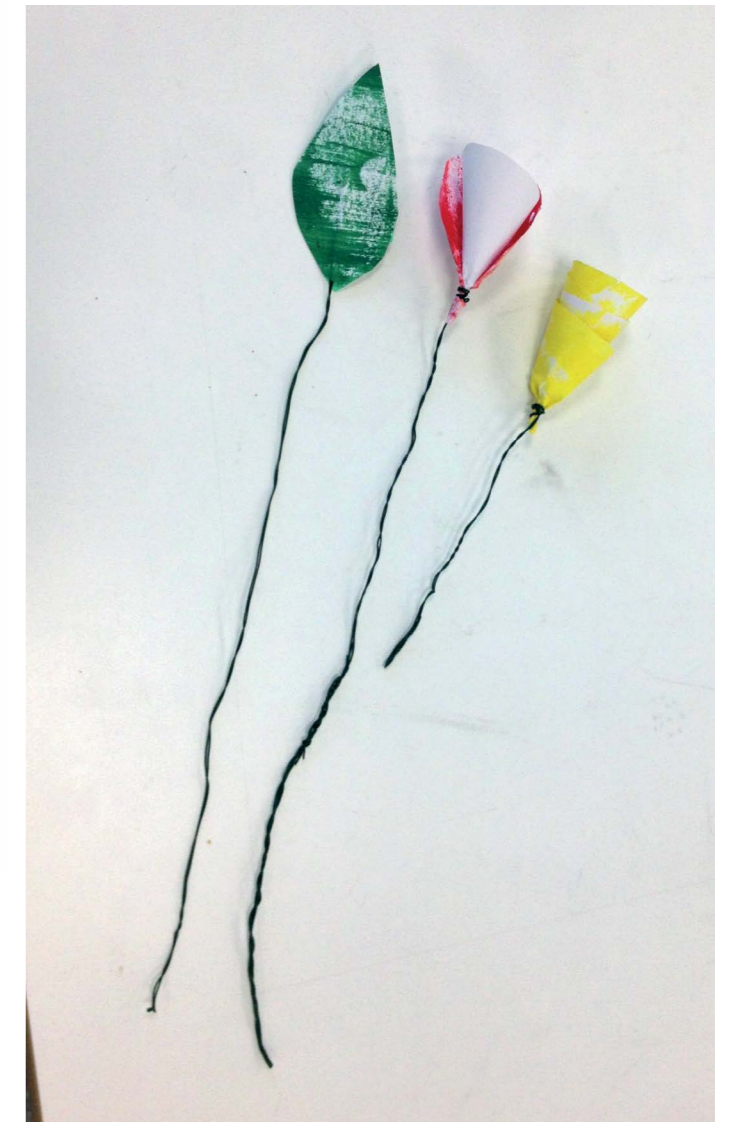


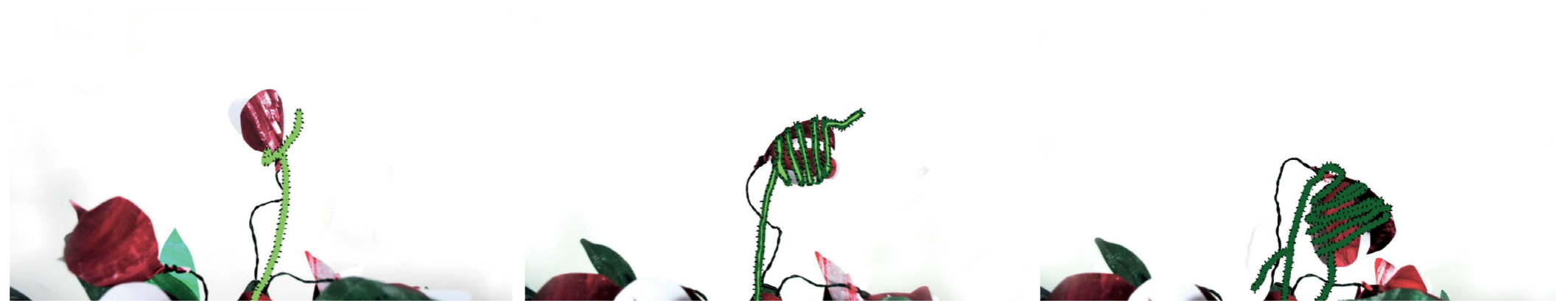
Don Giovanni
